Invasive Species Centre's European Gypsy Moth Egg Mass Scraping Terms and Conditions



Early Bird Draw: October 30, 2020 at 4 p.m. EST

Final Draw: November 27, 2020 at 4 p.m. EST

The more egg masses scraped, the more entries into the draw.

Every 10 egg masses scraped equals one contest entry.

The winner will be randomly selected. Only residents of Ontario, Canada are eligible for entry into the contest.

For verification, contest participants are asked to take a photo after their trees are scraped and submit it to the entry form where asked.

Following each draw winners will be contacted via the provided email for notification and mailing address request to receive their prize. Only the winners will be notified via the provided email.
